# WLD 100 Club Info & the Rules

To save on print costs this information is in small text as it would have taken 2 pages if printed this size, if you require larger text, please get in touch and one will be printed and posted/mailed to you.

Our 100 Club is open to all members, it costs just £5 per month and each number is entered in the draw every month; with the first and second numbers drawn receiving prizes.

## How it works

Half of what is collected every month goes to the Wearside Liberal Democrats (WLD) fund to finance our election campaigns and to print Focus leaflets, and the other half of the money is given away in the Prize Draw. The more numbers in the draw, the better the prize money, so encourage your friends and family to join in!

For example, if 100 numbers are entered each month at £5 per number, £250 goes to the WLD fund and there are two prizes of £150 and £100. You can join the 100 Club and pay by monthly standing order or annually by cash or cheque. You can have as many numbers as you wish at £5 per number. Your chances of winning a prize depends on how many numbers are in the draw, for example with 100 numbers you have a 1 in 100 chance of winning either the first or the second prize. If you have two numbers this doubles your chance of winning. Also, if there are fewer numbers in the draw, you have an even higher chance of winning (but the prize will not be as much).

## The Draw

The Draw Committee will hold the draw near the end of the month (at the general meeting if possible), and only the numbers paid for by the 20th of that month will count. If a number is drawn that has not been paid for we will draw again until someone wins.

The two winners will have their winnings transferred into their bank account, or sent by cheque, and their names published in the newsletter or on our website. The actual two-digit numbers will be produced by rolling two 10-sided dices (0-9), e.g. if the blue dice says 0 and the yellow dice says 7 the number drawn is 07. The numbers will be randomly allocated in the same way (but you will keep your number each month you stay in the 100 club).

Why is it the "100 Club"?

Many small societies and clubs use a similar lottery system to raise funds and they are generally called "100 Clubs" because they use numbers between 1 and 100, but if we get a lot of demand for numbers we can easily change to a "200 Club".

Please note, you must be 16 or over to participate.

## Rules

1. The "numbers" will be issued randomly and will only be available from the promoter or a designated member of the Draw Committee in the absence of the Promoter.
2. Each "number" is deemed to have been reserved for one year commencing April, purchased at £5 per month.
3. The fee for the "number" can be paid monthly by Standing Order, or annually by cash or cheque. Cheques should be made payable to "Wearside Liberal Democrats". Standing Orders set up directly by a member with their bank should notify the Promoter to expect the payment and that this is intended to be an entry into the Monthly Draw.
4. For each "number" to qualify for a Monthly Draw, the member must have paid-up their fee for the "number" by the 20th of the month in which the draw is to take place.
5. Each "number" purchased will be entered in to the Monthly Draw for two prizes.
6. There are no restrictions to the quantity of "number" purchased by the applicants, but applicants must be 16 years or over to participate.
7. The Monthly Draw will take place at the end of each month at a Draw Committee meeting, unless otherwise notified.
8. The winners of the prizes will be sent their winnings as soon as practicable after the draw, either by bank transfer or by cheque.
9. The results of the Monthly Draw will be published in a newsletter shortly after the draw.
10. The total amount collected for each Monthly Draw will be split 50% to the Monthly Prize Fund and 50% to WLD funds.
11. The Monthly Prize Fund will split into two prizes, one of 60% (first) and one of 40% (second)  
Please complete the Application slip on the front of this leaflet and return it to the promoter as soon as possible. Remember, a standing order can always be cancelled by contacting your bank, but please let us know as well.
